Reporting a Positive COVID-19 Test Result

If you tested positive for COVID-19 with a home test, the SDMs policy is to treat it as if you have COVID. Anyone can return to the SDM 5 (five) days after the initial positive home positive test result if you are asymptomatic. The SDM may require a confirmation PCR test if there is cause to believe that the student is falsifying the home test.

In addition to sending the dental school your results, please report your positive COVID-19 result to the University. As part of UB's comprehensive efforts to monitor and prevent the spread of COVID-19, the University has established a reporting process for students living onand off-campus who have tested positive for the virus.

- University staff will record positive test results and provide students with important information regarding health, housing, and academic resources.
- As necessary, students will be referred to their primary care provider or to UB Health Services for medical care. This process is not intended for treatment, diagnosis, or immediate care.

- Location of isolation (on-campus, off-campus with roommates/friends/other, offcampus with family, off campus alone)
