SECTION 2. SITUATION UPDATE

Provider of overview of project activities/update.

During the reporting period of July- August, the dental team continued conducting school visits in Bekaa. Children between the ages of 4-18 were examined during this reporting period. Daily coordination, follow-up, and weekly planning of schedule and identification of schools remained as planned with SAMS Lebanon team.

The performed activities were the same, as follows:

- Oral and dental examinations of the children at their schools (parental consent was obtained).
- ➤ Health promotion and awareness sessions were delivered on daily dental and oral hygiene, nutrition, and instructions on the protection of teeth
- Brushes and toothpaste were provided upon availability.
- Active caries was treated with SDF.
- > Teeth were coated with the fluoride varnish
- > Extractions and other treatments on site were performed by the dentists as indicated.



A total of 724 children were reached during the reporting month. About 51% (N=368) were males and 49% (N=356) were females. Most children were aged between 7 and 12 years of age (N=413, 57%).




July 2022

A total of 4 schools were visited: Al Andalos, Elm w Tamkeen, Gharsah and "We are there for each other". More than half of the children this month were seen were at the Phoenix (N=395, 55%).

August 2022

A total of 1136 children were examined during this month. 52% (N=588) were females and 48% (N=548) were males. Most children were aged between 7 and 12 years (N=775, 68%).



A total of 6 schools/locations were visited: Al Manara Center, Alam Alfurqan School, Aljadania Mosque, Dar Alquran Al Karim, Bunat Al Hadara School, and Al Andalos School. More than half of the children came from Al Manara Center (35%) and Aalam Alfurqan (30%).
