School of Dental Medicine's 2021 Bench Test

In early July, the University at Buffalo Dental School hosted the 2021 Bench Test preparatory course for international dentists. The course is optimal for those who may need better preparation in fixed and removable prosthodontics, operative dentistry, and treatment planning for the testing required by most U.S. dental schools as part of their admissions process.

Thirty-three international dentists participated in didactic and hands-on sessions under the guidance of School of Dental Medicine Faculty. Participants were trained in the state-of-the-art Virtual Reality Simulation Laboratory at the State University of New York at Buffalo, School of Dental Medicine.
