

Remembering Dr. Libuse Bobek, Professor, Department of Oral Biology

I am very sad to report that Libuse Bobek, PhD, a faculty member of the department for 24 years, passed away on Saturday, February 27th, just 2 weeks after her husband Miroslav, both the result of COVID.

Libuse received her BS and PhD in Biological Sciences from UB, and worked as a post-doc with Michael Levine. She became a full-time faculty member in 1993, was promoted to Professor and served until her retirement in 2012.

She made significant contributions to a variety of subjects, most notably in the regulation of salivary gland-specific gene expression, and in the characterization of several important salivary components, including Muc7, cystatins and histatins. She devised several anti-microbial peptides derived from salivary components, and held several patents. She held funding from NIH and other agencies throughout her career.

She supervised over 4 dozen dental, MS and PhD students and post-doctoral fellows, and directed the PhD program in Oral Biology for 8 years.

She was very committed to her students. And she was a nice person and good friend. Deepest sympathy to her children and grandchildren.
