Following the ceremony, guests were invited to a luncheon held at the Buffalo Niagara Marriott, Buffalo, NY. The ceremony welcomed and coated incoming International Dentist Program students as well as continuing students as they entered the third year of training.

Those attending the ceremony were families and friends of the students, school faculty and staff.

The White Coat Ceremony was designed by The Arnold P. Gold Foundation as a way to welcome new students into the medical profession and to set clear expectations regarding their primary role as physicians by professing an oath. The first White Coat Ceremony took place in 1993 at the Columbia University College of Physicians & Surgeons.

The cloaking with the white coat, the mantle of the dental profession is a hands-on experience that underscores the bonding process. It is personally placed on each student's shoulders by individuals who believe in the students' ability to carry on the noble tradition of doctoring.
