How do we determine your Budget?

 This is determined by the Dental School and Financial Aid Office and covers only 9.5 months. Budget accordingly.
 The maximum federal Unsubsidized Stafford Ioan eligibility per academic year is \$40,500. Interest Rate is 5.84%

Budget Adjustments

- Budget adjustments may be possible. Very Limited
- This can be determined by meeting with a financial aid advisor during the academic year 8/1-5/1.
- Health Insurance premiums: \$1,903 (UB charges this for the full year in the fall semester only)

Federal Direct Stafford Loans

For 1st Year Dental Students
 Federal Direct Stafford loans will be divided:
 56% -Fall Semester
 44%-Spring Semester

Graduate PLUS Loans:

You may borrow up to the cost of attendance less other financial aid awarded.

- Federal loan program with a fixed interest rate of 6.84%
- Credit check required.
- A separate promissory note and entrance counseling session is required.

Economically Disadvantaged First Professional Study Program (EDPS)

- To be considered for this partial tuition waiver, you must:
- Be enrolled as a professional student in the Medical, Dental, Pharmacy or Law Schools
- File your FAFSA by March 1 of each award year
- Be a resident of New York State
- Be either a U.S. citizen, or eligible non-citizen
- Have a demonstrated Exceptional Financial Need
- Meet income requirements based on your family size.
- Must Include parent information on FAFSA

Health Professions Loans

- You must provide your parental information on the FAFSA to be considered
- File the FAFSA by March 1st
- Subsidized- 5% fixed rate, 12 month grace period

 Required paperwork must be completed each semester
 Will be mailed to the local address on file
